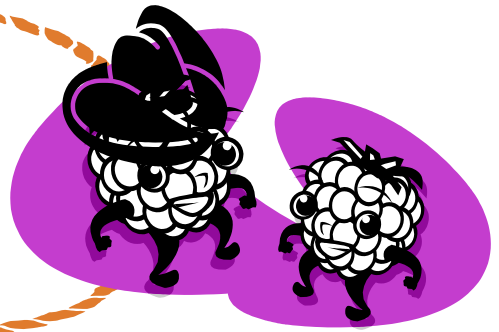

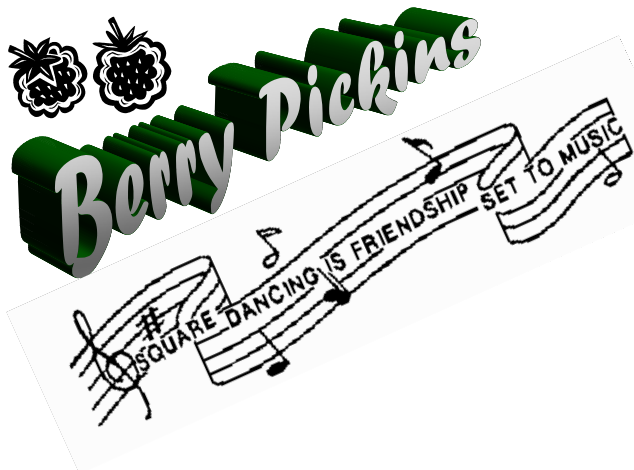


VISITATIONS
