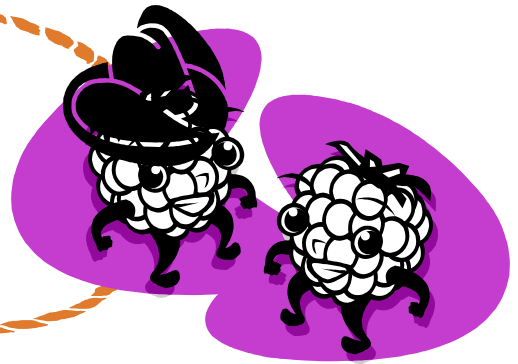

A Sq. D

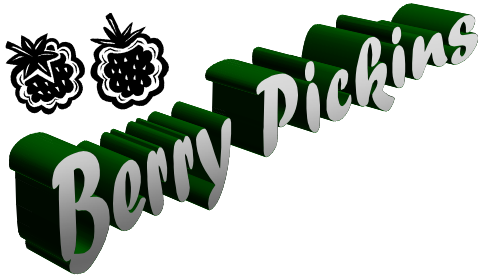
