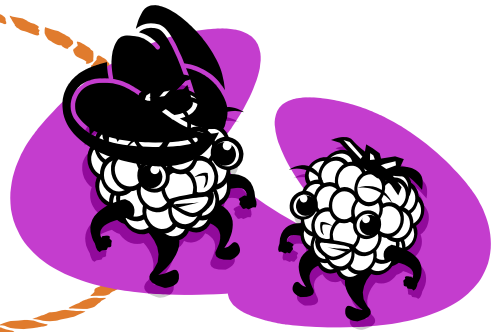

Ribbons: A square D will provide ribbons that say "Ask me about Square Dancing".

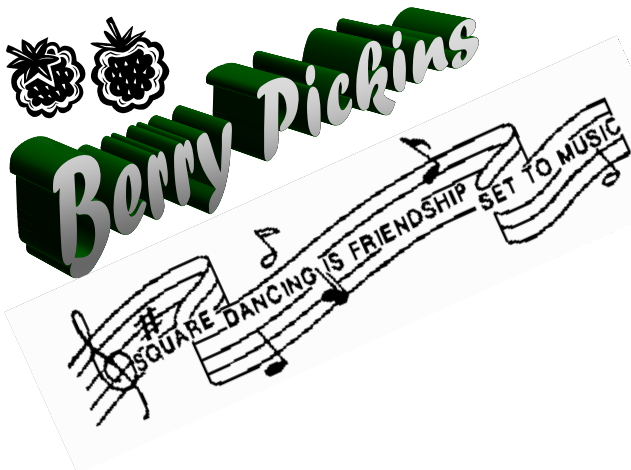
Business cards: A square D will provide business cards that have phone numbers and web site information regarding square dancing. Also, please use your own club cards and handouts.
