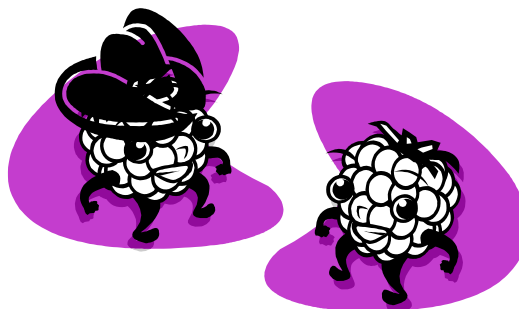

If you want to get into the Orange County fair free, and also have free parking, all you have to do is sit at the square dance booth for three hours. See our president, Fred Willbanks, for details.

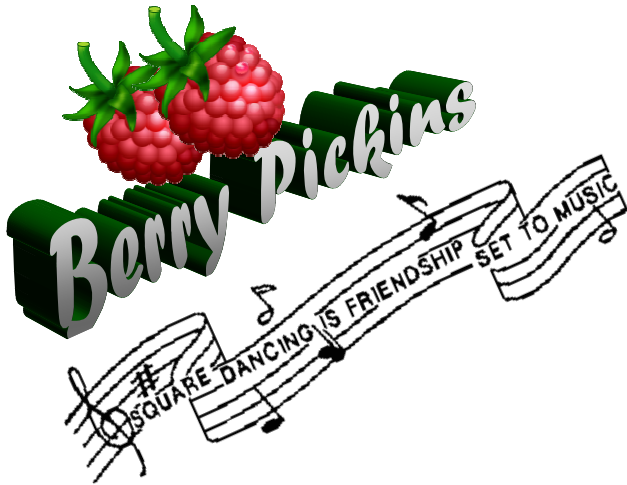
CARD SHOWER

President's Message:

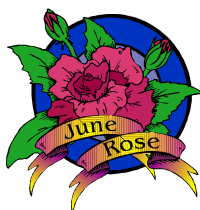
