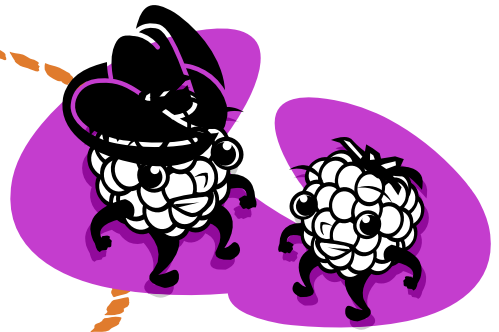

58th NATIONAL CONVENTION

June 24th, 25th, 26th, and 27th

What to say to those who don't want to attend the convention because they can't get a one day only pass. Ask them to consider these:

1. Yes, it does cost a lot more than a Saturday night dance but you get so much more than you would at an ordinary week end dance. There will be 20 plus rooms with activities (seminars, clinics, exhibitions, special events) going on at all times.
2. This will probably be the last time in your life time to attend a national convention in southern California. (Unless you plan to still be dancing 20 years from now.)
3. Where else will you see so many vendors all together?
4. Where else will you see so many dancers from many other states and countries?
5. Dancers from far away find the convention exciting enough to pay hundreds of dollars (travel, hotels, restaurants) more than the registration fee.
6. You contribute to charities and causes that you believe in. What better cause is there than the promotion of square dancing? The convention is a non profit organization. Consider the cost of the registration fee a contribution to your favorite activity.
7. A lot of dancers are putting in many volunteer hours into putting the convention on. They are working hard. It would be nice to reward them by purchasing a registration even if you can't go at all!
8. The convention can't afford to issue one day passes. If they did, half of the local people would buy one day passes. This would gain the convention approximately \$1,000 dollars and they would lose approximately \$40,000.

ORANGE COUNTY FAIR

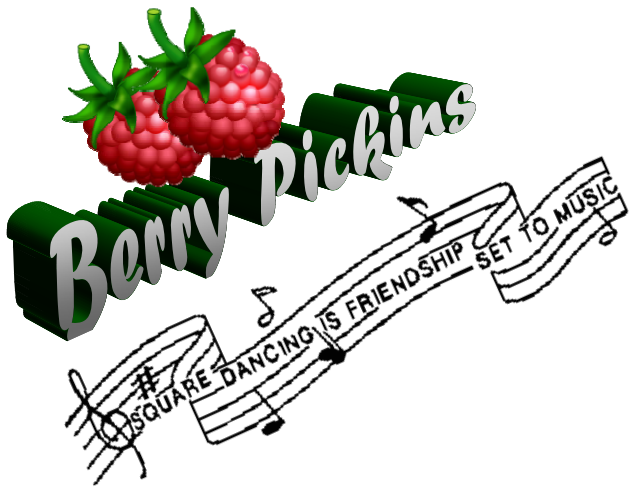

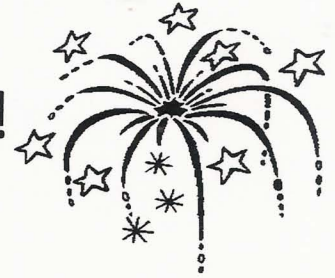
