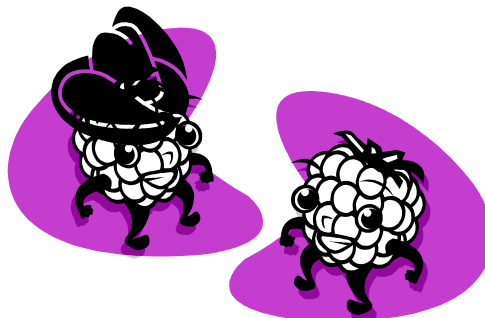

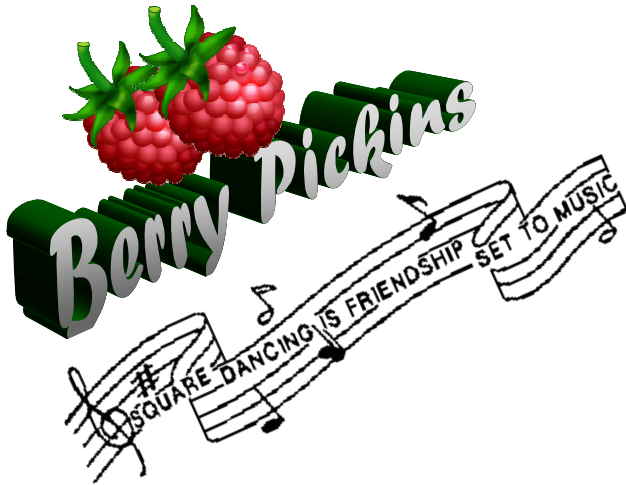
NEWS FROM OTHER CLUBS

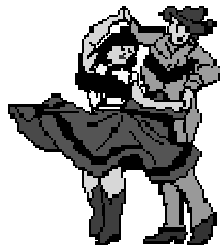


President's Message:

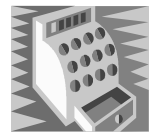
