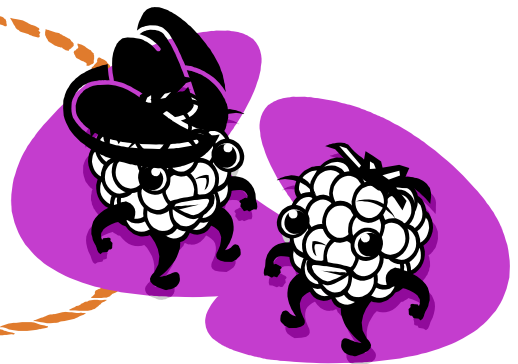

### **ASSOCIATED SQUARE DANCERS IS SPONSORING A SQUARE DANCE PROMOTION DAY ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2007**

“Ask Me About Square Dancing” Square Dancers across Southern California have launched a campaign to raise the awareness about the benefits of square dancing, round dancing and line dancing which includes, meeting new people and making new friends all with the benefits of low impact aerobics.

Many of the square dance clubs are sponsoring beginner square dance classes starting in September and the inquiring people will be encouraged to join the square dance community and attend one of the square dance beginner classes.
