1. It provides low cost insurance, both medical and liability. Most facilities insist on liability insurance.
2. It provides the 501 c7 non-profit and tax exempt status.
3. It helps promote classes by providing: give away pens, "Ask Me About Square Dancing" ribbons, full color tri-fold, full color business cards, and 800 telephone numbers.
4. It assists clubs by providing diplomas, mainstream and plus handbooks, double roll tickets, beginner badges (with ASD logo).
5. It organizes special dances (Student Stomp, Sweetheart Ball, Leprechaun Ball, Presidential Ball and Spring Fling)
6. It provides leadership assistance as requested such as conducting graduations and installation ceremonies.
